In this was, B.C. 673-672, Esar-haddon carried the remnant of Israel into captivity and sent Manasseh, king of Judah, to Babylon. In the following year, B.C. 671, Manasseh was pardoned and restored." (George Smith, quoted by David L. Cooper, pg. 295, *Messiah: His First Coming Scheduled*). The years of Judah's sin (40 in all) suspend their counting at this point when Manasseh repents. Likewise the counting of broken sabbatical years also suspends at this point. Esarhaddon invaded Egypt in his 10th year after the Syro-Palestinian Campaign (ANET).
