KJV Ezra 3:8 Now in the second year of their coming unto the house of God at Jerusalem, in the second month, began Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the remnant of their brethren the priests and the Levites, and all they that were come out of the captivity unto Jerusalem; and appointed the Levites, from twenty years old and upward, to set forward the work of the house of Yahweh.

KJV Daniel 10:1 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a thing was revealed unto Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar; and the thing was true, but the time appointed was long: and he understood the thing, and had understanding of the vision. KJV Daniel 11:2 ... Behold, there shall stand up yet three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than they all: (Smerdis, Darius, Xerxes) [Xerxes, the 4th from Cyrus]

KJV Ezra 4:4 Then the people of the land weakened the hands of the people of Judah, and troubled them in building, 5 And hired counsellors against them, to frustrate their purpose, all the days of Cyrus king of Persia, even until the reign of Darius king of Persia. 6 And in the reign of Ahasuerus, in the beginning of his reign, wrote they unto him an accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.

The tablet that describes the 7th year of Kambyases (Cambyses) and various astronomical positions is found in Franz Xaver Kugler's Sternkunde und Sterndienst in Babel, published in 1907, pages 70-71. Darius I (Hystaspis)

KJV Haggai 1:1 In the second year of Darius the king, in the sixth month, in the first day of the month, came the word of the LORD by Haggai the prophet. (Tuesday, 8/29 520 B.C. JP; BIB & BAB)

KJV Haggai 1:15 And they came and worked on the house of YHWH of hosts, their God, 15 on the twenty-fourth day of the month, in the sixth month, in the second year of Darius the king. (Thursday, 9/21 520 B.C. BIB & BAB)

KJV Haggai 2:1 In the seventh month, in the one and twentieth day of the month, came the word of the LORD by the prophet Haggai. (Tue 10/17 520 B.C. B&B)

KJV Zechariah 1:1 In the eighth month, in the second year of Darius, came the word of the LORD unto Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet.

KJV Haggai 2:10 In the four and twentieth day of the ninth month, in the second year of Darius, came the word of the LORD by Haggai the prophet. (Mon 12/18 520 B.C. B&B)

KJV Zechariah 1:7 Upon the four and twentieth day of the eleventh month, which is the month Sebat, in the second year of Darius, came the word of the LORD unto Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet, saying, 1:12 Then the angel of Yahweh answered and said, O Yahweh of hosts, how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years? (Thur 2/15 519 B.C. JP-BIB & BAB)

KJV Zechariah 7:1 And it came to pass in the fourth year of king Darius, that the word of the LORD came unto Zechariah in the fourth day of the ninth month, even in Chisleu: 7:5 Speak unto all the people of the land, and to the priests, saying, When ye fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh month, even these seventy years, did ye at all fast unto me, even to me? (Sabbath 12/7 JP-BIB & BAB: n.b. Equinox = Adar 15, 10h 21m.)

KJV Ezra 6:15 And this house was finished on the third day of the month Adar, which was in the sixth year of the reign of Darius the king. (Thur 2/10 515 B.C. JP-BIB; The Babylonian date yields Sabbath 3/12/515. This shows they had returned to the biblical calendar upon the return, and that it was Adar I, not Adar II.)
