KJV Ezra 7:8b-7:9a It was the seventh year of the King, that on the first of the first month he established the going up from Babylon.
(Tuesday 4/4, 397 B.C.-JP-BIB). But the Bab New year was the next month, so it still was the 7th year of the king at this point. (The 7th yr clause goes with following phrase, not the preceeding).

KJV Ezra 8:31 Then we departed ... on the twelfth day of the first month, to go unto Jerusalem: (Tuesday 4/4, 397 B.C.-JP-BIB)

KJV Ezra 7:8a, 7:9b And he came to Jerusalem on the first of the fifth month (Thursday, 7/20/397 B.C.-J.P.-Av 1).

KJV Ezra 10:6 Then Ezra rose up from before the house of God, and went into the chamber of Johanan the son of Eliashib; and when he came thither, he did eat no bread, nor drink water: for he mourned because of the transgression of them that had been carried away. (9th month, 18th day = Sabbath, 12/2/397 B.C.-JP BIB.)

KJV Ezra 10:9 Then all the men of Judah and Benjamin gathered themselves together unto Jerusalem within three days. It was the ninth month, on the twentieth day of the month; and all the people sat in the street of the house of God, trembling because of this matter, and for the great rain. (Monday, Dec. 4, 397 B.C. JP-BIB only).

KJV Ezra 10:17 And they made an end with all the men that had taken strange wives by the first day of the first month. (Tue, 3/13/396 B.C.)

Daniel 9:25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven sevens and sixty and two sevens: 62 sevens begin counting.
