Claudius d. Caligula, Jan 24

KJV Acts 12:21 And upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his throne, and made an oration unto them. 22 And the people gave a shout, saying, It is the voice of a god, and not of a man. 23 And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost.

KJV Galatians 2:1 Then through fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and took Titus with me also.

Jerusalem Council

KJV Acts 18:2 And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them. (cf. Finegan §680).

KJV Acts 18:11 And he continued there a year and six months teaching the word of God among them. And when Gallio was the deputy of Achaia, the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul, and brought him to the judgment seat.

KJV Acts 19:10 And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.

Acts 20:7 On the first of the Sabbaths, when we met to break bread, Paul was holding a discussion with them; since he intended to leave the next day, he continued speaking until midnight. April 16, A.D. 57 = Sabbath, 22 Nisan.

Paul's arrest

Acts 24:27 But through two years Porcius Festus came into Felix' room: and Felix, willing to shew the Jews a pleasure, left Paul bound.
