Joseph took over control of the administrative State, having all power except in name only, and ruling in place of Amenemhet III. Amenemhet IV was not the direct heir, and was controlled by Joseph.

Journey to Bring Jacob to Egypt

(A) For these two years hath the famine been in the land; and yet there are five years, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest. Gen. 45:6.

(B) And Jacob said unto Pharaoh, The days of the years of my pilgrimage are an hundred and thirty years: few and evil have the days of the years of the life of my fathers in the days of their pilgrimage. Gen. 47:9.

(C) Then be Ya'aqov in the land of Mitsrayim seventeen years. Then be the days of Ya'aqov, the years of his life, seven years, and forty, and a hundred years. Gen. 47:28.

The Masoretic Hebrew text has 49 x 47 + 1 = 2304 years. I have not found that the LXX or SP can make this synchronism. Generally they fail to.

The Old Assyrian KEL and MEC year names may be resynchronized before the gap in KEL G using the 1841 BC solar eclipse.

Around this time Egyptian hieroglyphics are assigned phonetic values to represent the 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet, most probably by Joseph or his sons Ephraim and Manasseh. The Genesis stories, either from memory, or from tablets in cuneiform are committed to writing in this new script, which was eventually adopted by other Semitic peoples. Probable transmission chain: Shem had memorized the early part of Genesis, and committed this to Isaac at Salem. Probably a copy was kept on tablets in addition to memory. This was transferred to Jacob after returning to Canaan, and then to the sons of Israel in Egypt, where it was handed down to Moses in the new writing system. All persons in the transmission line lived at least 147 years. Its accuracy is re-certified under Moses.

Each Assyrian Eponym year begins with the new moon on or after the fall equinox.
