And when Yahweh raised them up judges, then Yahweh was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented Yahweh because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them. Judges 2:18. *I cite this text over and over against to confront those who try to deceive us by overlapping Judges with Oppressions.*

B 720 year *Distanzangaben*. This king Tukulti-Ninurta I said there where 720 years from the time of Ilu-Shuma to his own time. This works out to 2002 BC, the first king at the head of the Assyrian King List. Since Ilu-Shuma's reign length is not known, this figure is used to compute it along with the 1841 BC eclipse.

Year 34, IV Shemu 24, day of festival of ***; Full Moon, June 25, 1270 BC.

Yahweh delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: Judges 2:18.

And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of Yahweh. Judges 10:6-7.

And that year they vexed and oppressed the children of Israel: eighteen years. Judges 10:8. *'That year' refers to the year Jair died, the 301st year.*

Ammonites

Will not whatever Chemosh thy mighty causes thee to dispose, it thou will disposes, and all which Yahweh our Almighty has caused to be disposed at our faces, it we shall inherit. And now, being better thou are better than Balaq son of Tsipor, king of Moab? Contending He had contended with Israel whenever fighting has had fought against them, (while dwelling Israel in Heshbon and her daughters, and in Aroer and her daughters and in all the cities which are upon the hands of the Arnon) three hundred years. And why have ye not caused deliverance in that time?

While Israel was camped on the plains of Moab, Balaq hired Balaam to curse Israel. But it was not Yahweh's will to curse Israel, and so Balaq failed. Balaq was killed by Israel in the 40th year after the Exodus. In Judges 11, "Contending He had contended" refers to Yahweh's subsequent contention with evil Israelites during the servitudes, the first of which began 319 years before Jephthah's speech, but during 300 years Ammon took no advantage to disposes Israel. Jephthah is underlining their weakness. In other words, from the first opportunity permitted 300 years earlier, they had taken no advantage of any divine permission to attack Israel. And now Ammon thinks it is better than Balaq in attacking Israel when it is Yahweh's will to deliver Israel. Then Jephthah proceeds to appeal to Yahweh to fight for Israel.

Jephthah remembered the Song of Moses (Deut. 32:24-25).

They put away the foreign gods and served Yahweh. Then he grieved over the misery of Israel. Ju. 10:16.

Judges 11:26 speech. See A. above.

Jephthah of Gilead

And Jephthah judged Israel six years. Then died Jephthah the Gileadite, and was buried in one of the cities of Gilead. Judges 12:7

A proto accession year is inferred here. Proto-accession years are possible in other judge after judge successions.

Ibzan of Bethlehem

And he judged Israel seven years. Judges 12:8.

The Jubilee in year two of King Saul prevents overlapping of any minor judges after Jephthah.
