

# Nabonidus

9 Jan 555 = Thoth 1

His father was Nabū-balātsu-iqbi, a lesser son of Nebuchadnezzar, who was described as "The Wise Prince" in inscriptions, who married Adad-guppi, the priestess of Harran, and became its governor. They begat Nabonidus. When Labashi-Marduk was deposed by a conspiracy, Nabonidus took the throne.

26. From the time of Assurbanipal, king of :A..ssyria, until the 9th year 27. of Nabu-na'id king of Babylon, the son, offspring of my womb 28. 104 years of happiness

40. endure not, (but) let him worship thy great godhead. In the 21 years 41. of Nabopolassar, king of Babylon, in the 43 years of Nebuchadrezzar,
