Antiochus IV

He began his reign in the 137th year of the Greeks. 1 Mac. 1:10.

A liberal Jewish faction appeals to Antiochus to authorize the introduction of forbidden Hellenistic customs into Israel, which he authorizes them to do, setting aside the Torah, which had been the Law in Judea from the days of Ezra. 1 Mac. 1:11.

Ptolemy's plan to attack Coele-Syria was discovered by Antiochus, and so Antiochus was ready for the Egyptians, and defeated them. The Seleucids seized Pelusium, and so as not to alarm Rome, Egypt's ally, they allowed Ptolemy to continue ruling as a puppet at Memphis. Only Alexandria remained unconquered, which declared a new king, the brother of Ptolemy VI as Ptolemy VII. The brothers resolved not to fight a civil war, and so Antiochus resolved to take Alexandria by force, but the Roman ambassador drew a line around him on the ground and said he should leave Egypt, and give him a reply before stepping out of the circle, or he would be at war with Rome!

Antiochus retreats back to Jerusalem in a rage and begins to take out his wrath on the Jewish nation.

1st Egyptian Year ended with 12 Oct, 204 BC. Reign began July/August 204, at the age of 5
