Re: Notes on Church "Fathers"

Generally we have only Catholic sources for these. In some cases their writings have been corrupted to conform to Catholic heresies. If they have been so corrupted their witness is not valid. If they have not been corrupted they witness against themselves. They cannot even be trusted to report their opponents positions accurately. Whatever I cite a Church Father saying is what the Catholics claim he said.

Hermas: false book put in Canon. Teaches false doctrine of baptism.

Justin Martyr's First Apology

False teachings: Immortality of the soul; eternal torment of the wicked; solemnization of Sunday; gross abuse of Plato and misquoting Scripture; baptismal regeneration; remission of sins by baptism; transubstantiation of the Eucharist.

Justin Martyr's Dialogue with Trypho, Anti-Semitic remarks:

We too, would observe your circumcision of the flesh, your Sabbath days, and in a word, all you festivals, if we were not aware of the reason why they were imposed upon you, namely, because of your sins and the hardness of heart. The custom of circumcising the flesh, handed down from Abraham, was given to you as a distinguishing mark, to set you off from other nations and from us Christians. The purpose of this was that you and only you might suffer the afflictions that are now justly yours; that only your land be desolated, and your cities ruined by fire, that the fruits of your land be eaten by strangers before your very eyes; that not one of you be permitted to enter your city of Jerusalem. Your circumcision of the flesh is the only mark by which you can certainly be distinguished from other men...as I stated before it was by reason of your sins and the sins of your fathers that, among other precepts, God imposed upon you the observance of the sabbath as a mark.

Irenaeus: taught forgiveness and cleaning from sin by baptism. The baptism heresy is the same heresy as the circumcision heresy condemned by Paul to the Galatians. Neither baptism nor circumcision remit the guilt of original sin. Only Messiah's death does, and only affirming faithfulness to Him can appropriate his faithfulness to forgive. Let him who says otherwise be anathema.

Clement of Alexandria: taught forgiveness and cleaning from sin by baptism.
