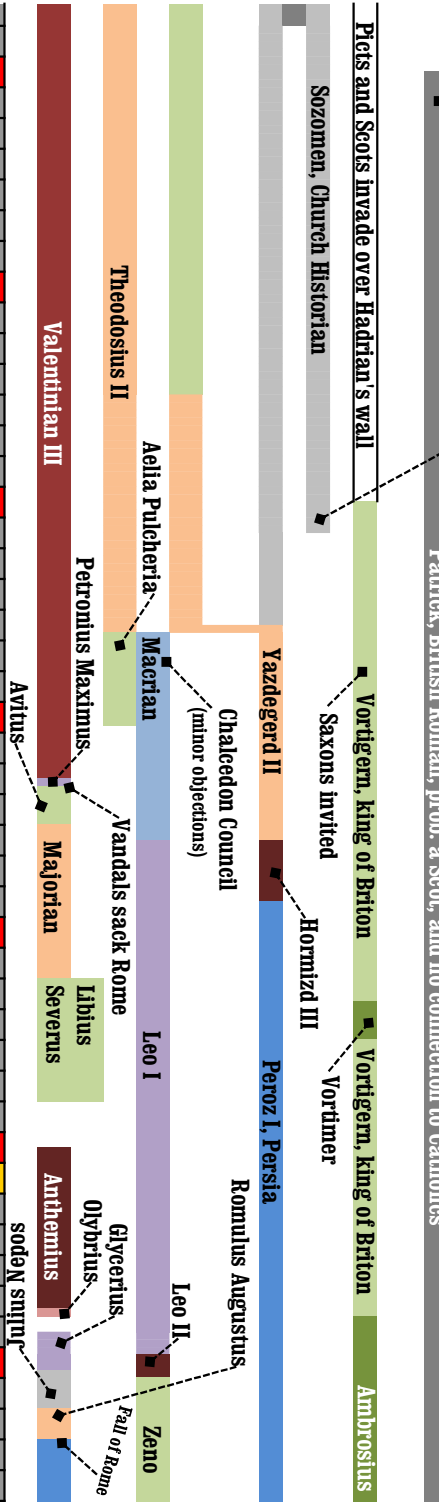

Sozomen: Assemblies are not held in all churches on the same time or manner. The people of Constantinople, and almost everywhere, assemble together on the Sabbath, as well as on the first day of the week, which custom is never observed at Rome or at Alexandria.

N1, Churban txt: 364, emend 36(5) = Sab Cycle 1, 1 Heshwan, rosh hodesh.

S15, N15, Z308: Thu/ss, 6 N[isan]/sr; emend 400 H acc. to Stern to 399, Sab cycle 7; G: no match; Z: no match; W (not emended): Mar 26, 470

Churban Era 400 is three years different from AM 4231 (tanna'im); red and purple col. at right, outlined in white. Thus 4231 - 3 = AM 4228. 4228 synchronizes with Churban Era 400. The calculation is the same using the Judean World Era and the Judean Churban, blue and green columns, 400 and 4231 outlined in red.

Shalom. Shalom on you as you lie here." Either 400 or 407 H. Friday, G: June 20, AD 475. Z: Jul 25, 469; W: no match.
