Asa son of Abijah

He commanded Judah to seek Yahweh...and to keep the law. 2 Chron. 14:4.

Then Baasha kills him in the third year of Asa, king of Judah. Then he reigns under him. 1 Kings 15:28. In the third year of Asa, king of Judah, Baasah began to reign, the son of Ahijah, over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty-four-years. 1 Kings 15:33. *The inclusive count is because of dynasty change by violence.*

In the 15th year...there had been no war until the 35th year of the kingdom of Asa. 2 Chron. 15:10, 19.

And the days which Jeroboam had reigned were twenty-two years, and he slept with his fathers. Then Nadab his son reigned under him. 1 Kings 14:20. And Nadab son of Jeroboam began to reign over Israel in the second year of Asa king of Judah. Then he reigns two years. 1 Kings 15:25. *The accession year is by the default rule, but if it is ignored here then an accession year must be used for Elah.*

No. 10: IK 15:32-16:7

Baasha son of Ahijah

There was war all the days of Baasah with Asa, but it did not come into Judea.

So Abijah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead. In his days the land was quiet ten years. 2 Chron. 14:1. *There was war all the days of Baasha with Asa, but the war did not come into the land of Judah. Also this may be view as no foreign war came into Judah for 10 years.*

Idols purged from all land under Asa's power.

Zerah, the Nubian General of Osorkon I, and his million man army invade Judah; 2Chron. 14:9.

Great numbers from Israel settle in Judea.
